

As a friend of Ozanam Family Shelter, you are amazing and we would not be able to shelter homeless families without you. This year brought so many changes! With the loss of two area family shelters, Ozanam went from being the largest to now the only family shelter that can accept a whole family or single fathers in Evansville. The demand for our services is growing and we have had to think outside the box to be able to expand our program.

This year, we modified our Case Management Team and formed a partnership with Aurora Inc. We now have one Ozanam Engagement Coordinator and a Housing Coordinator through Aurora. We also rearranged the facilities to make space for more family rooms and implemented a House Manager to help with the influx of people needing our services.

The growing pains will be worth it as we see our clients reach their goal of obtaining stable housing for themselves and their children.
